

## **CHANGES TO THE LINCS LEAGUE**

After the meeting on the 24<sup>th</sup> Jan the clubs in attendance agreed to the suggested changes for this year Track and Field league and County Champs.

The information on the data base for the league program is the same as required for entries into the Track and Field Championships so to ease the work load on the dwindling list of volunteers, all athletes who are registered by their clubs will be given a number; this number will be used by them not only in the league, but also in the county champs if they compete in them.

Additions will be allowed throughout the season.

The numbers will be provided by the county at the start of the first match or at the start of the next match/competition after they have been registered by their club.

A charge of 10p per number used by the club will be payable after the final Lincs League match.

Damaged numbers will be replaced free of charge, lost numbers will be charged for at a cost of 50p to be paid by the athlete/parent.

For this to work the amount of numbers allocated to clubs has changed and the clubs need to register athletes prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> match as the numbers will be printed as and when required.

A list of previously registered athletes along with the clubs allocated numbers will be sent to the clubs for them to amend and return a.s.a.p. for the 2012 coming season.

Paperwork for the league matches has changed; there is no need for a declaration sheet prior to each match. The only paperwork required is a list of the clubs hurdlers and if possible steeplechasers to allow the correct amount of lanes to be set up plus any new additions to the list of competitors.

There is also a new registration form for athletes being registered throughout the season.
